Edward C. Robinson, age 71, died peacefully on Thursday, August 18, 2022, at Christiana Hospital in Delaware after a long battle with cancer.

Edward was born on June 18, 1951, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to Mary (nee Dolhancryk) and John Robinson. He was originally from the Fairmount section of Philadelphia and a member of the St. Francis Xavier Parish. He moved to Northeast Philadelphia in 1974 where he raised his three children. In later years, he relocated to New Castle, Delaware with his mother to help take care of her.

Ed was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, James (Janet). He is survived by his brothers, John and Thomas (Rita), and his children, Jason Robinson (Tori), Gabrielle Robinson, and Sarah Berrios (Carmelo).
