Edward Vernon Walls, Sr., passed peacefully at the age of 96, on May 6, 2019 at Dock Woods Community in Lansdale, PA. Ed was born February 8, 1923 to Frank and Helen Walls. He graduated from Lansdale High School where he was captain on the cross country and track teams. He was also a member of the boxing team.
