Eugene Phillip McCormick, Jr. "Phil", died November 17, 2018 in Paoli Hospital. He was born in Buffalo, NY, September 20, 1942, the son of the late Eugene Phillip McCormick and Belle (Keefe) McCormick. His work includes hospitals, education and research facilities, and other public institutions in the eastern US, South America and the Caribbean. With his wife Christine he conducted educational programs directed at creating a sustainable suburbia and provided local planning advice. Avid sailors he and Christine cruised the east coast for 30 years, and he was a golf enthusiast. Active in the Episcopal Church and charitable

organizations throughout his life.
