Rev. George N. Anderson, S.J. died peacefully on August 4, 2020 in Merion Station, PA. Father Anderson's entire Jesuit life was devoted to serving the poor and imprisoned, largely in the Washington and New York metro areas. He also wrote extensively for, and served on the editorial board of, America magazine.
