George J. Kowalski, age 87 of Fairmount, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on January 15, 2025.

George was born on August 3, 1937 in Port Richmond, as member of St Adalbert parish. At 17 years old, he enlisted in the U.S. Army and joined the 11th Airborne Division. He often described this time of his life, in the service, as one of the greatest moments of his life.

George met his wife Joan, of 64 years, in Fairmount while working at his father's bar on Taney and Brown. They were married in 1960 and raised their 3 children while remaining in Fairmount.

George worked for many years and later retired from Acme warehouse.

George was a devoted husband, and a dedicated family man, who enjoyed hunting, reading, music (esp. Elvis), and walks to the library. He was a kind and compassionate man with a gentle heart. George asked for nothing, but gave everything. He was a family first man, and will be missed sorely.
