Grace L. Freeman, age 95, died September 9, 2021 at The Willows Retirement Home in Hatfield. She was a longtime resident and native of Hatfield and Lansdale.

Grace was born in 1926, the ninth of 11 children of Helen (Huston) Longaker and John Ullmann Longaker. Her father was the longtime owner of the Longaker Hotel in Lansdale, where Grace spent her childhood. She was predeceased by her husband of 54 years, George Freeman and her 10 siblings.

Grace graduated Lansdale High School in 1944. She then worked one year in Philadelphia for Bendix Aviation Co., earning recognition as a "Rosie the Riveter" for the manufacturing job she did to help in the WWII effort.

In later years Grace worked in a Lansdale factory that produced instant coffee, and also for Penn Elastic in West Point.

She is survived by several nieces and nephews.
