



## Mary Ann Sabokbar

March 4, 1932 - August 3, 2020

On August 3, 2020 Mary Ann (Wallis) Sabokbar, beloved mother and grandmother, passed away peacefully at home at the age of 88.

Mary Ann was born and raised in Shepperton, England. She lived through the dark years of WWII, spending time in air raid shelters and watching the overhead bombing of London take place. She pursued a career as a Nurse, working both in the hospital and also as a Nurse Midwife, riding her bike to deliver babies at home. It was in a Pediatric Hospital in London where she met a physician named Nasser, whom she wed on August 1, 1959. Together, in the Spring of 1960 they came overseas to start a new life in America. They also started a family which grew into two daughters and their families. Mary Ann continued to work as a pediatric nurse here, even obtaining her Bachelors of Nursing Degree from Penn State University after both her daughters had graduated from college.

Mary Ann had passion for tennis, gardening, reading, art, music and animals. She was well versed in British Heritage and History and could recite dates and facts at any given time. Part of her love for her home country was kept alive through her involvement with the local chapter of the Daughters of the British Empire (DBE). It was through the DBE that she met many wonderful friends, whom she kept close in her heart.

Church of the Messiah was also a big part of Mary Ann's life. She was active in volunteering as well as attending services, until she was unable to do so. Mary Ann led a very humble life, and continued to worship at home.

Mary Ann will be dearly missed by her family and friends. She was a woman with strong morals and a dignity that she maintained until the end. She never lost her love for her home country, and always cherished her British Heritage. She is survived by her daughters; Julie Sabokbar and Karen (Sabokbar) Hartley, Greg Hartley (spouse). Grandchildren; Josh, Andi (her spouse Nicholas Repine) Samantha, Matthew and Sarah; Great-Grandchildren; Chase and Jack.
