



Nick Cvetkovic

April 18, 1945 - May 25, 2024

Nick Cvetkovic of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, passed away on May 25, 2024. Cause of death was a heart attack. Mr. Cvetkovic was born on April 18, 1945 in Leipzig, Germany. He emigrated to the United States in 1955. He attended Central High School (220th Graduating Class) and Drexel University, graduating with a BS in Business.

Mr. Cvetkovic was a sergeant in US Army, stationed in Germany, during the Vietnam War era. After his military service, he went on to found NBC Computing Associates where he worked as a consultant for over thirty years. Upon retirement, he founded Nick Cvetkovic Tours and specialized in walking tours of Philadelphia's Historic District. He was active in national, regional, and local tour guide organizations including serving a term as the president of the Association of Philadelphia Tour Guides.

His survivors include: his wife, Vibiana Cvetkovic; his daughters, TK Cvetkovic and Natasha Evans; his step-children, Elizabeth Idler, Anna Simonetti, Michael Kassabian, and David Kassabian; his eleven beloved grandchildren; his brother, Rudy Cvetkovic; his niece Erica Cvetkovic; and his nephew, Derek Cvetkovic.
