Robert Ordo of Philadelphia, passed away on March 16, 2024, at age 69. Bob was predeceased by his parents, Iona (Malley) and Stanley R. Ordo, and sister, Mary Anne Ordo. He is survived by his brother, Stanley J. Ordo, sister-in-law, Grace Hanrahan, and half-brother, Paul Davis.

Robert, known as Bob to family and friends, was very bright as is evident from his graduating from Philadelphia's Central High School (Class 231) and earning a master's degree in social work from Bryn Mawr College and a master's degree in educational psychology from Temple University. For several years, he worked as a social worker for the City of Philadelphia, providing services for senior citizens and homeless people. Later, Bob worked as a school psychologist in the Philadelphia School District, providing psychological testing for school children.

Bob was deeply religious and believed in the power of prayer. At one point, he even considered joining a religious order. Despite his many health problems, he remained confident and interested in medical research. Bob was optimistic and willing to try innovative medical methods as possible solutions to his health issues.
