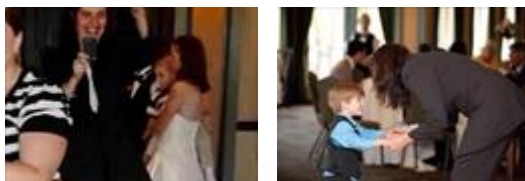
Terry, A part of us went with you when God called you home. Our broken hearts will always hold a special place for you. God bless you always. We love you.
